2009 Rules of the Festival for Vendors

1. All parking of vehicles during festival hours is restricted to the front parking field facing Highway 171. The only exceptions to this rule will be for campers in the primitive camping area, and vehicles owned or operated by Middlefaire staff or management. Vendors may drive out on the faire lanes in the morning, between sunup and 10:00 A.M. to set up their stock---after 10:00 A.M., they are to park their vehicles out front, and utilize the patron parking field until 7 P.M. Violators will be subject to towing.

2. Vendors are never to drive their vehicles on the village grounds of the festival during faire hours, for any reason. To do so endangers the public walking the lanes. Violators of this rule may be subject to impoundment of booths and/or expulsion from the faire.

3. Craft vendors are responsible for trash at their sites, and should bag and tie (or knot) garbage bags as needed to control gnats or flying insects. Vendors should not interrupt faire staff during the festival with demands that trash be attended to; they should stow tied bags in a discreet location off the lane, and the bags will be picked up by management at a more convenient time.

4. Food vendors should only dispose of their waste and trash in heavy-duty or contractor-grade trash bags. Food waste should never be packed into open bags, cans, jugs, or boxes.

5. Built booth vendors should landscape their own weeds and grass surrounding the booths. Faire personnel will mow close to built booths, but we ask that built booth vendors invest in (a) a weedeater, or (b) a push mower, and use them in the square footage areas immediately surrounding their booths.

6. Middlefaire is a privately owned land site, and the Middlefaire Company and its respective landowners possess---and will enforce if necessary---**unlimited rights to refuse entry to patrons, participants, or vendors** who are problem individuals, or who are deemed to be in breach of contract, or who are deemed to no longer be in good standing with the festival.

7. The Middlefaire Company is the sole vendor of all beverages served to the public at festivals held onsite. Faire vendors are not to serve or vend beverages during faire hours without written contractual approval from the management. Serving alcohol to <u>anyone</u> onsite during faire hours, at any location other than the Jack Tar Tavern, is expressly forbidden.
